Description:

One scholarship of \$500 is awarded to a member of the baseball team and one to a member of the softball team who are graduating seniors of Camp Point Central High School.

Purpose:

- → To encourage participation in organized baseball and softball
- → To provide financial assistance to financially needy college or university-bound students
- → To encourage baseball and softball players in the Central school district to pursue further education
- → To recognize academic and leadership talent

Applicant Requirements:

Graduating high school senior baseball players and softball players who wish to apply for the Roy Dean Perry Scholarships must submit a completed application to their high school guidance counselor by May 1st. A minimum ACT score of 21 or SAT score of 990 is required to be eligible for the scholarship. The student's high school transcript and two letters of recommendation must accompany the application.

Scholarship Award:

The recipient's college or university will receive a one-time installment of \$500 to be applied to the expenses of the student's attendance. The financial aid office of the recipient's college or university will be paid directly.

The Roy Dean Perry Scholarship is awarded to recipients based on criteria established by the selection committee and may or may not be awarded at the sole discretion of the selection committee. In the event there are no eligible senior participants in the baseball/softball programs, the committee may elect to award the scholarship to past recipients or an eligible participant of another sport.
